Time in class will be spent mainly answering students' questions from the homework. Otherwise, we will go over other examples to solidify the material that has been presented during lectures.

In general, Homework will be graded as follows: assignments will be graded out of 20 points. 5 problems will still be graded, except now they will be worth 3 points each. 1 point will be given if work is shown. 2 points will be given if work is shown and about half of the material of the question is understood. 3 points will be given for 75+% comprehension determined by parts of the answer that are correct as well as correct work shown. That adds up to 15 of the 20 points for each homework assignment. The other 5 will be given just for doing the work of the entire assignment, giving credit for your efforts. The best 5 homeworks will count toward the final grade.

In general, quizzes will consist of 2-4 questions and will be graded out of 10 points. The best 5 quizzes will count toward the final grade. No graphing calculators will be permitted during quizzes and no sharing of calculators will be allowed.
