1. ACT Math score of 27 or more OR
2. ACT Math score of 20-21 AND College Algebra placement score of 0-11 AND Trigonometry placement score of 12 or higher OR
3. ACT Math score of 22-26 AND College Algebra placement score of 12-24 AND Trigonometry placement score of 7-11 or higher OR
4. Passed MATH 0980.

Required materials: Scientific calculators are allowed in this course. However, Graphing calculators are NOT allowed in the course except TI-83.

Text: Precalculus. Larson \& Hostetler, Brooks/Cole, 8e.
Attendance: Attendance is essential for success in the course. You are expected to be present in every lecture and recitation. Random attendance will
be taken during lectures and recitation which will count towards a portion of the grade.
